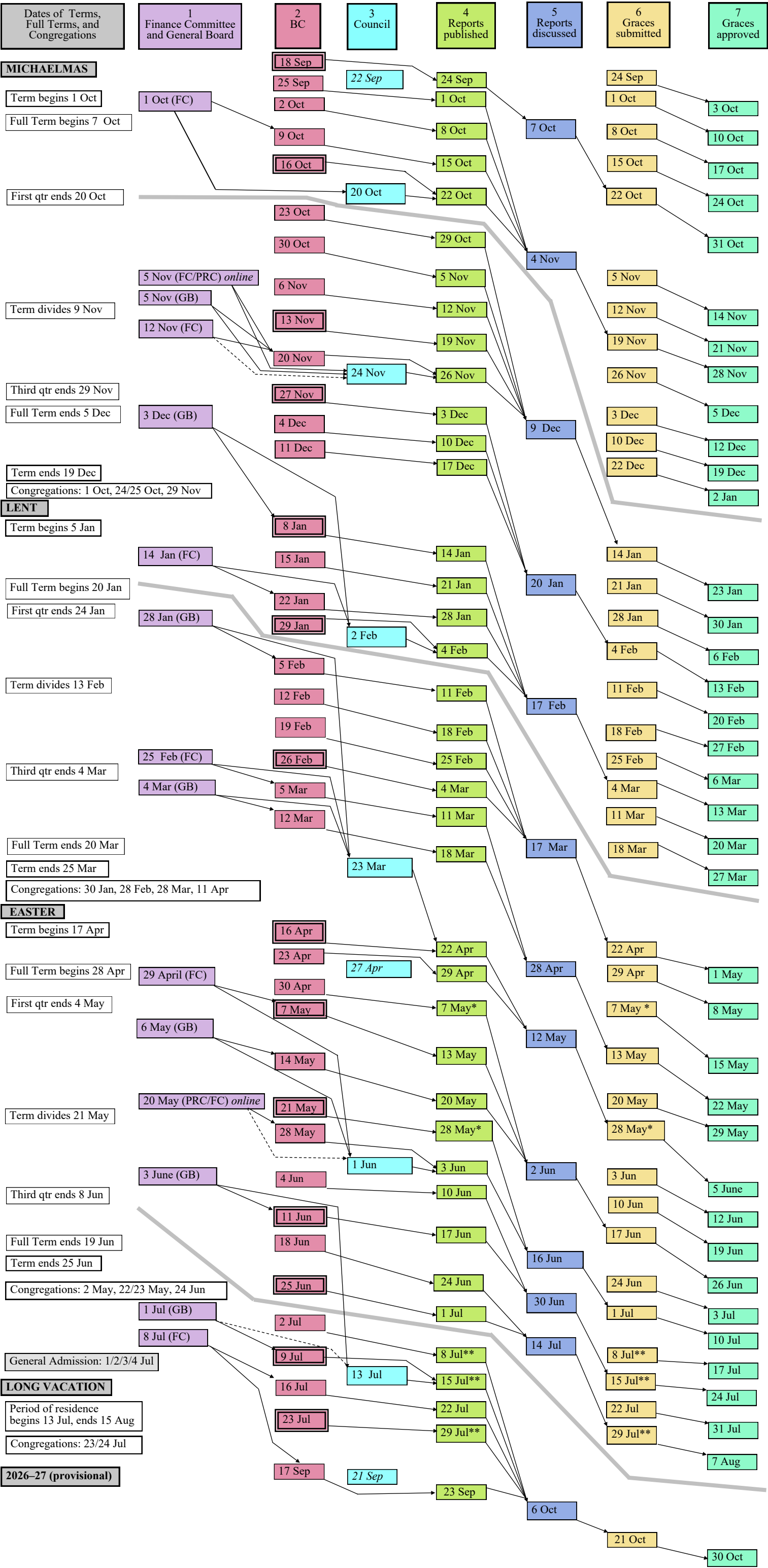


REPORTS AND GRACES, 2025–26

Reports. The arrows lead to the **earliest** date by which each stage of the progress of a Report can be completed. The dates in **columns 6 and 7** will be effective only in cases where no remarks are made at the Discussion: if any remarks are made at the Discussion, the Council or its Business Committee (BC) will need to consider them and this may result in a delay of at least a further week. Italics indicate Council strategy meetings. Double-lined boxes indicate dates on which BC meetings are expected to take place online; approval by circulation is more likely on other dates. The grey lines indicate the dates for the approval of a Report before the next Term begins. Unless otherwise stated or agreed in advance, most meetings are expected to take place in person. Please contact the Secretariats in advance to agree timelines, particularly those indicated by dotted lines.

Graces. Any Grace submitted to the Regent House by being published in the *Reporter* on one of the dates shown in **column 6** will, unless it is withdrawn or a ballot is requested, be deemed to have been approved at 4 p.m. on the corresponding date in **column 7**. No Graces will be submitted on 29 October for approval on 7 November, because the new Roll of the Regent House will be promulgated part-way through that period on 6 November 2025. Any Graces published on 17 December will be submitted on 22 December 2025 for approval on 2 January 2026.
